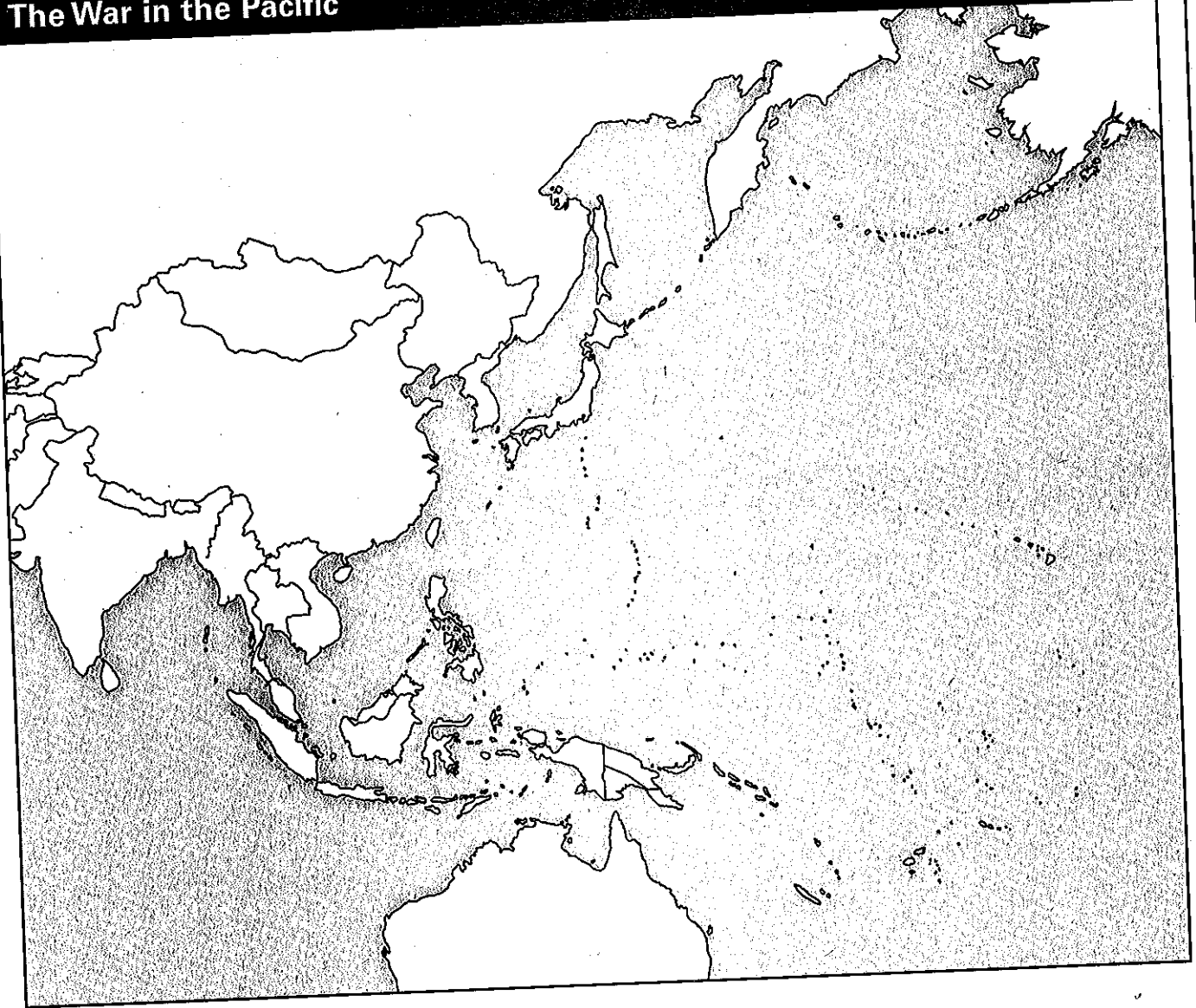

1. What territory did the Japanese control in 1942?

3. What is “island hopping”?

4. Where is Midway, and why was it important in World War II?
 - Label Midway on the map. Draw a symbol to represent the Battle of Midway.
5. Where is Iwo Jima? Why might it have been important in World War II?
